## What is this project about?

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*SMART VET offers a Strategic cross-sectorial Partnership among VET organizations and youth organizations aimed at preparing an improvement program designed to increase the ability of VET teachers, trainers and mentors to foster VET students' transition to the labour market.*

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The project contributes to the VET students' employability skills increase, especially during suspension periods as the lockdown due to the COVID-19 crisis. For this reason, the 7 partners, coming from different sector sands with different specialties and capitalizing on experience in VET services, employment services, skills development, formal and non-formal education, decided to share their expertise to develop new tools and design materials to support apprentices/VET students to enhance the transversal skills needed by the current labour market.



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## *Final events in the partner's countries*

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During the project, the partners had the possibility to explore new options to support students in acquiring the so-called employability skill.

In this last part of the project, partners will share the lesson they learned while cooperating with the partners, how students responded to the program and will find new ways to replicate it in the future. The partners organized different local events with the following topics

- Brainstorming with participants to create follow up projects and initiative
- Planning for sustainability: looking for sponsors and support to replicate the program in the future

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## *Multiplier event in IT*

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The final event was organized in Torino on the 20th of June. The project manager presented the partners and the tools we prepared. We presented the project and the results we produced together with the partners and there results we gained from the pilot testing. We had the educator who performed the piloting explaining the tools and the results. Our associates are trainers, coaches, and entrepreneurs. We also have contact with several local municipalities and their youth centres. Teachers from the school we performed the piloting have been invited too. We started the process of transferring the materials to the school we piloted the e-course with and we



had a short brainstorming session on how to use the materials in the future.



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### *Multiplier event in CY*

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RESET has organised the SMART Multiplier Event on the 22nd of June 2023 at Roots the Space in Limassol at 18:00. The event will also be attended by the Adult Education Centres in Cyprus which will also carry out multiple workshops for the participants. Discussions will also be taking place in regards to the VET sector in the case of Cypriot context.

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### *Multiplier event in TR*

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Targeting professionals and organisations from key strategic stakeholders, the Multiplier Event was conducted on June 16, 2023, at the American LIFE Conference Room in Turkey-Samsun. Twenty VET educators, teachers, Volunteers, and representatives from Schools, Stakeholders, and NGOs were in attendance. In order to demonstrate the usefulness and efficacy of IO1 and IO2, as well as the lessons learnt from utilising them with other target groups, we presented them to a group consisting of VET teachers from various schools, trainers, and public-school representatives. Because of their importance to the project's long-term viability, we want to make sure these individuals are well-informed and prepared to advocate for the programme in a variety of settings.





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### *Multiplier event in RO*

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The local multiplier event took place at Ana Aslan School in Romania, Braila on 15 of June targeting professionals and organizations from key strategic stakeholders. The participating had been VET teachers from three different schools, trainers, public school representatives, an employee organization called Oficiul de Recrutare Personal, and a civil society organization known as Asociatia Magia Binelui. These stakeholders have been kept informed and engaged since the project's inception through various channels, such as website and social media.
