The project responds to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development under Goal 8 on “Promoting sustained, inclusive and sustainable growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all” and is also directly linked to SDG 4 on education. Developing skills needed for a sustainable economy is already recognised as a critical business issue and even if society and companies are moving toward a greener economy, embedding sustainability or ethical business practices into companies' business is more challenging than just “help the company go green”.

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PARTNERS' TRAINING IN PORTUGAL

During the 1 semester of the project, the partners organized a training in Santarem, PT.



The staff was involved in a “learning by doing” methodology, which allow them to experience the learning method by themselves and increase their ability to replicate it in the future.

They learned how to monitor the impact of the learning outcomes using the results produced by the project. The aim of the training is to increase the potential of the project and have the teachers and educators in the partners' organizations be able to create, maintain and improve the tools in the long period.
