



CIRCULAR ECONOMY & ENTREPRENEURSHIP TO BOOST VET STUDENTS' EMPLOYABILITY AND RESILIENCE

Context

The project supports the enhancement of competences as critical thinking and forward-thinking, collaboration, entrepreneurial mind-set and other key transversal competences needed to succeed on the actual labour market.

Considering the increasing importance of SUSTAINABILITY SKILLS in the EU market and the employment opportunities connected to it, increasing sustainability skills or increasing knowledge on circular economy, while fostering an entrepreneurial mind-set.

Entrepreneurial skills are used as activators of a wider set of competences requested by the actual labour market and that have been already formalised by other EU level institutions.

Developing skills needed for a sustainable economy is already recognised as a critical business issue and even if society and companies are moving toward a greener economy, embedding sustainability or ethical business practices into companies business is more challenging than just “help the company go green”. The time and cost effective solution should free educators from preparing the contents, helping them in focusing on how to facilitate skills acquisition and final validation of the results.



THE RESULTS

Skills cards

The partners studied and analysed different EU level skills and competence framework, to create a list of the skills and competence the labour market needs. The list has been then validated with different experts and it is now available on the project website.

Educators manual

The second tool created by the partners is the MANUAL FOR GREEN AND RESILIENT VET EDUCATORS. The contents are useful for educators and trainers that need to know more about circular economy and entrepreneurial competences. The manual is available on the project website and on the website of the partners.

Digital library

The partners are now working to produce the CEE VET library, composed by ready to use materials as (micro-lessons, text, games, reading materials, exercises, presentations, infographics...) that VET teachers can associate to any class or lesson on key concepts encompassing sustainability, entrepreneurial skills, responsibility. The different resources are presented in different format to allow teachers to have a variety of different tools that can be easily associated with any class or activity.
