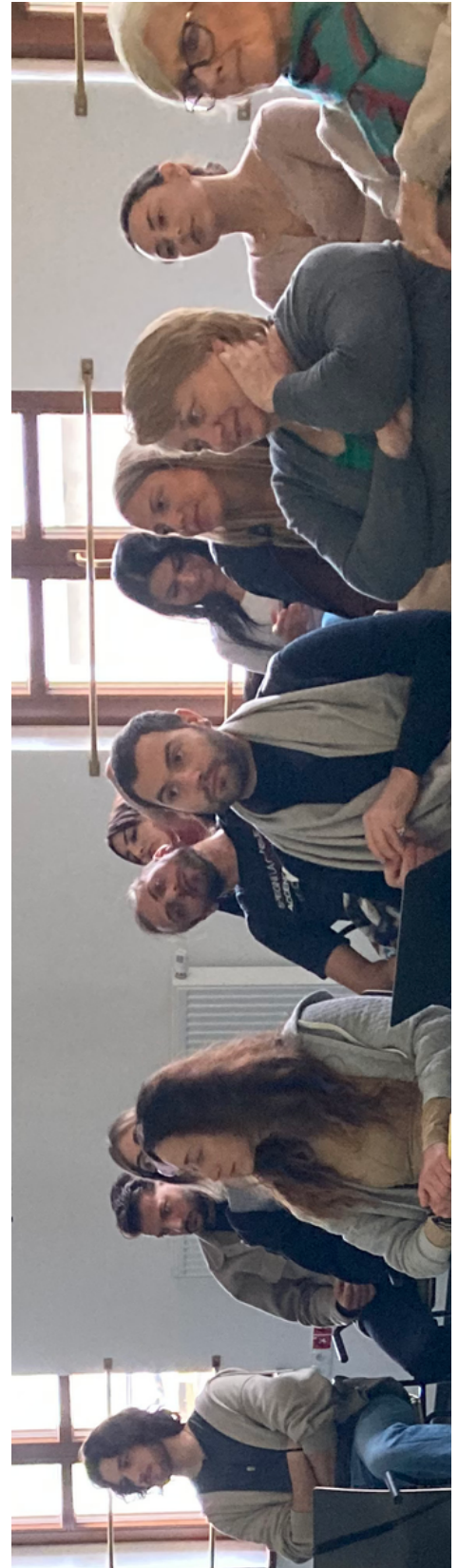

VISION

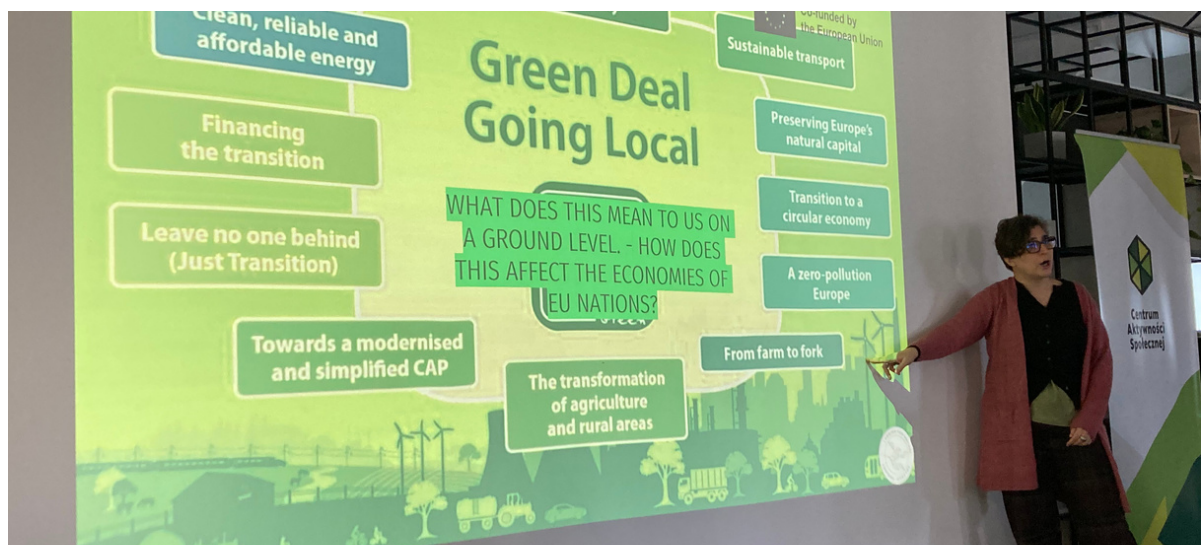
Use sustainability, inclusion and empowerment as inspiration to contribute to the continuous improvement of people and society.

The purpose of this event was fivefold:

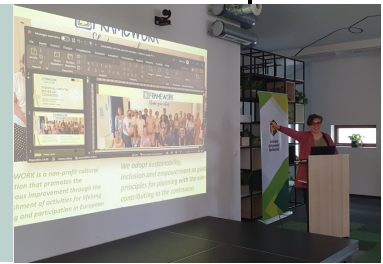
1. To be a part of a global movement that directly contributes to achieving sustainable development goals.

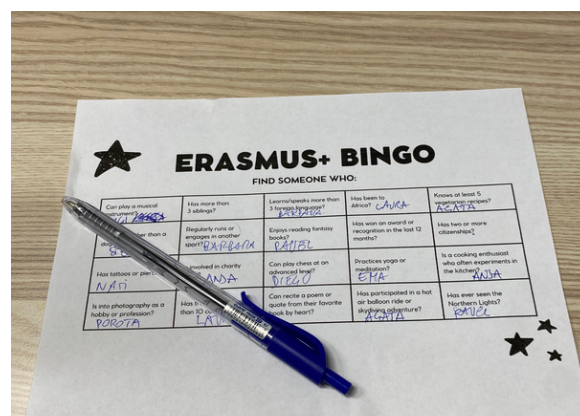

The first day of the training has been dedicated to team building activities, icebreakers, getting to know each other and presenting the project goals.

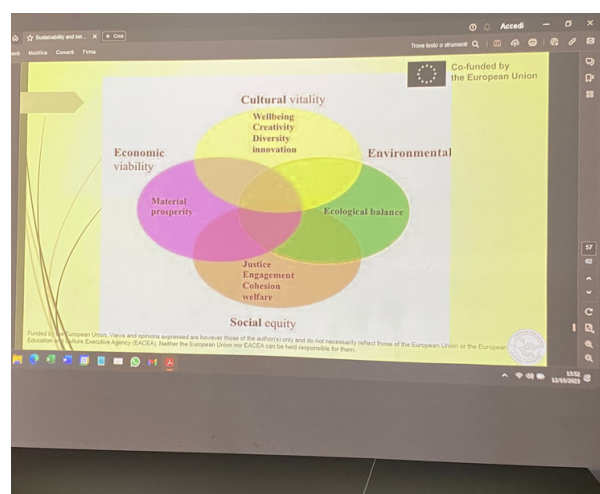


02 DAY

FRAMEWORK presented

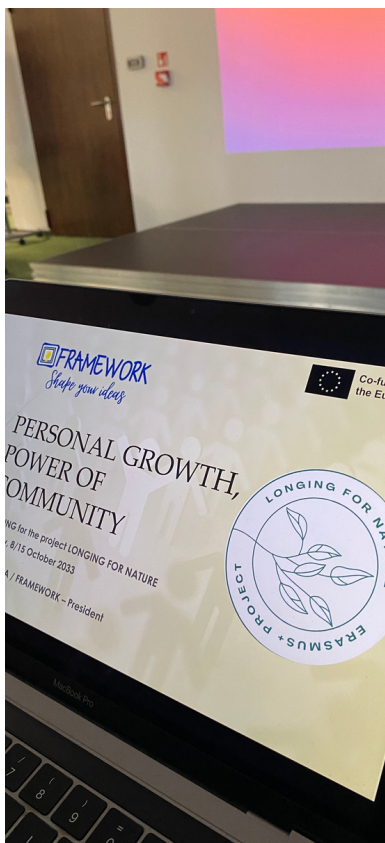

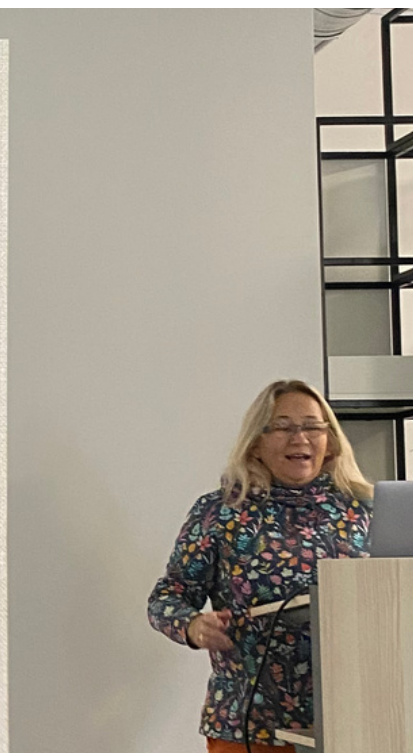
